AWARENESS IN BEREAVEMENT CARE FOUNDATION TRAINING COURSE 2012

Would you like to be able to help those who need support after a bereavement?

Cruse Bereavement Care is a national charity providing bereavement support to those who need it after a death. This support is offered free of charge by trained volunteers. In Bexley and Bromley this is provided to people in their own homes.

The Awareness in Bereavement Care foundation training course has been designed to provide an understanding of the grieving process and to develop vital skills in working with those who have suffered a bereavement. The Bexley and Bromley Area will be running the course between March and May 2012.

Course Information:

The course will be delivered at the Adult Education College, Sidcup on Tuesday evening plus three full Saturdays between 6th March and 29th March 2012. The fee will be £300, which may be paid in three instalments.

Entry requirements:

No counselling experience is necessary – anyone interested in offering support to the community is welcome to apply. You will need to be able to commit time, both for support sessions for clients and for ongoing training for yourself.
