- 1. Tell us a little about yourself, and what interests you about the role
- 2. What skills and interests do you have that you think will help you in this role?
- 3. What do you understand about confidentiality in the context of this role?
- 4. Have you worked or volunteered in a role before where you've had contact with the public? If "no": what kind of approach do you think you'd need to this kind of role?
- 5. This role involves working independently with support if needed from BVSC is this something that you're comfortable with?
- 6. Do you have any questions for us?

Additional questions dependant on role:

- 1. We have a strong ethos and legal organisational requirement to make sure that we are maintaining confidentiality at all times, do you have experience of this is some form?
- 2. Some people will be facing serious social issues, as well as poor physical or mental health. What do you think that means for the role, and how you might need to approach people with difficulties?
