Who Are GlamSci?

GlamSci is a STEM educational and diversity charity based in Bexley, but work nationally up and down the country provide support to schools, colleges and community project to support learners into careers in STEM.

We work with all disadvantaged young people, regardless of background and any axes of social difference. However, we acknowledge that the following groups require additional support and make an effort to engage with and create resources and opportunities for them so that they can realise their potential as individuals and STEM professionals. These groups include:

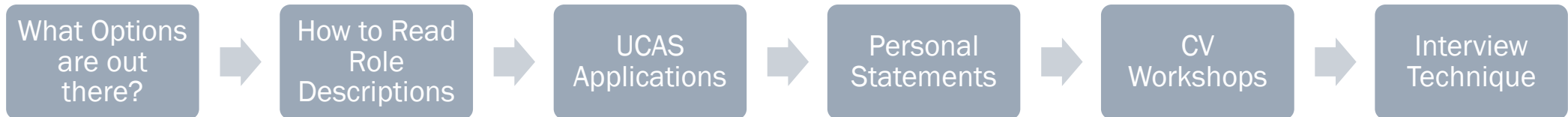
- young women and men;
- young people Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET);
- those with a history or at risk of being involved with gangs;
- young people from ethnically diverse backgrounds;
- LGBTQ+ young people;
- young people with Special Educational Needs (SEN);



What we will be covering?

Even though we are a STEM charity our careers support will cover all roles and give general careers advice.

Our programme will cover the following:



This programme aims to give practical examples of how to brush up your CV and covering letters, how to apply or re-apply to university, and how to ace that interview!

Sessions are held once a month, and then uploaded to Youtube, for asynchronous learning.

1:1 Support Programme

As well as offering a careers advice programme we will also be offering a 1:1 support programme for those seeking work to sign up to.

In these sessions we work with people to look through their CV's, supporting redrafting them, mock interviews, supporting writing personal statements.

The 1:1s will help those looking for work really polish their skills, and show employers how they can make a difference in their work place.

With the 1:1 support these will be run weekly, but can be requested for other times to fit around job-seekers lives.

Those that have so far worked with us on a 1:1 basis have gone on to secure work during COVID-19.
