The NHS Long Term Plan

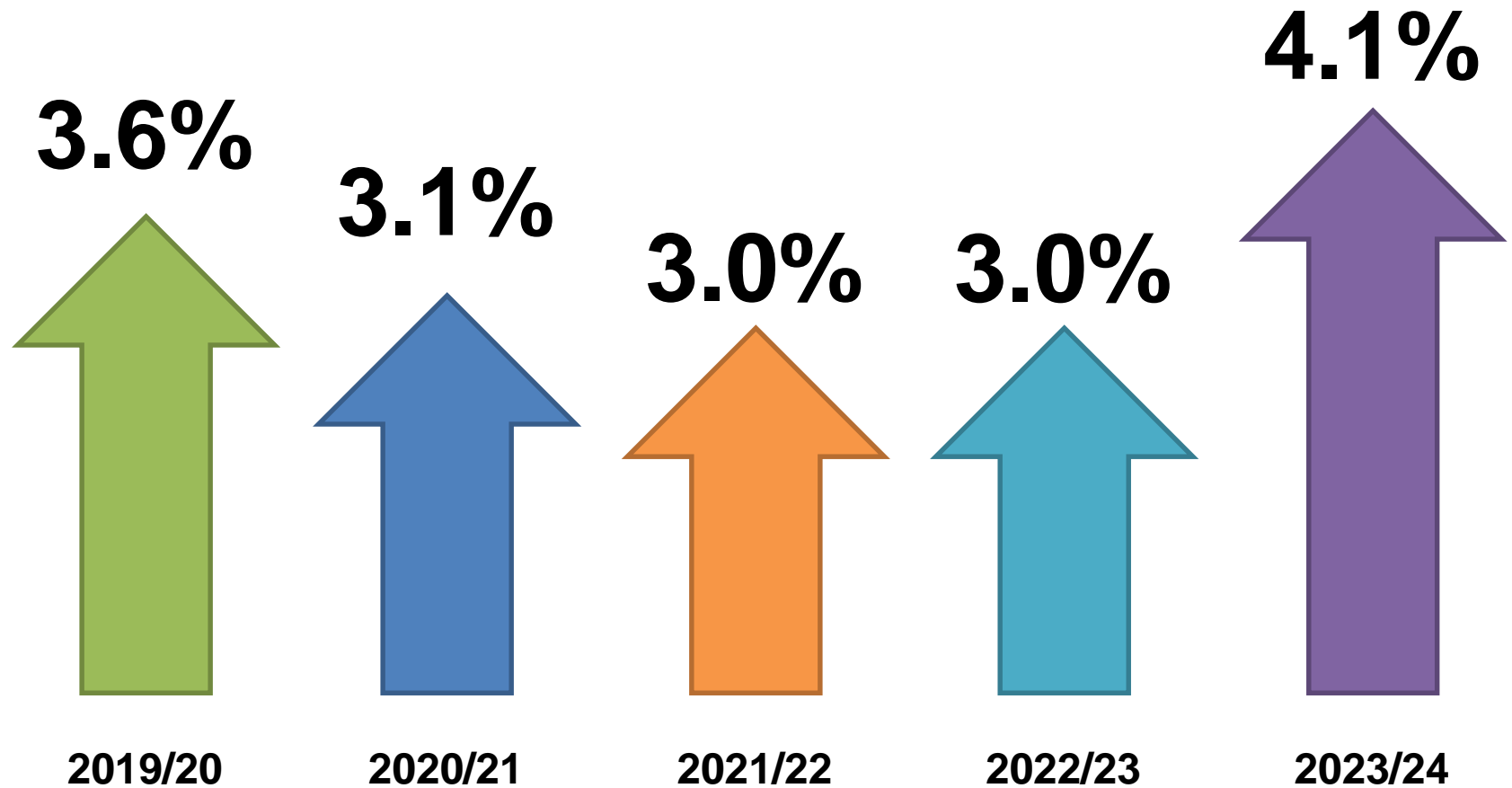


- Published 7th January 2019
- Sets NHS ambitions for the next 10 years
- Builds on previous NHS Five-Year Forward View
- Underpinned by new funding deal secured from Government

Primary and Community Services Improved



- £4.5bn uplift to primary medical & community health services
- Improved out-of-hospital care
- Formation of Primary Care Networks (PCNs)
- Strategic move to place-based population health



Integrated Care across South East London

- Integrated Care Systems (ICS) will be in place across the country by 2021
- The ambition in South East London is that there will be an ICS in 2020
- This will require a single CCG at STP level
- Local decision-making around 'place' for each borough and neighbourhood will still be necessary
- Local 'place-based' boards are expected to manage this



Workforce is a key risk

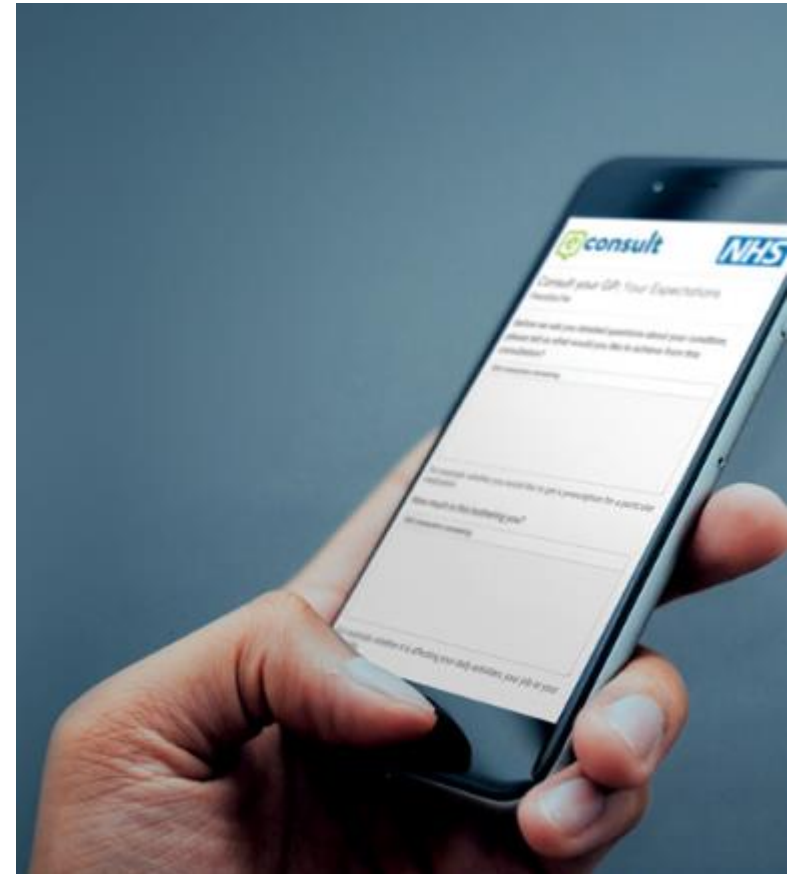


- The NHS has key risks around workforce, particularly in nursing and medical professions
- The LTP will be followed by an NHS Workforce Implementation Plan
- The 2019 Spending Review will determine the training and development budgets

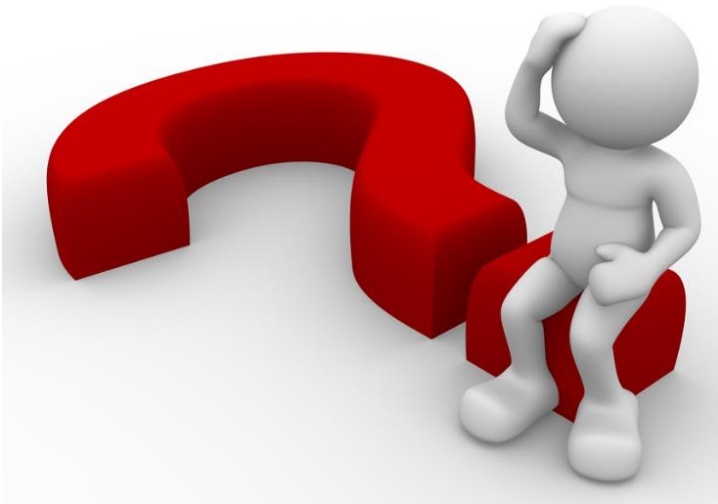


Commitment to Digital

- The LTP recognises that the NHS has lagged behind in embracing digital innovation and seeks to address this
- Every patient will have the right to a telephone or online consultation
- Digital options for outpatients aims to reduce 30 million patient visits per year
