# Help we didn't gather the data we thought we would

Approach

Helpful- I couldn't get this, but I've got that.

Learning- we have adapted our data collection so that this will be improved next time.

Honest and wise – don't over or undersell





## Help! Our survey data doesn't look that great!

Ask questions of your survey, eg IIA survey 'Have you made tangible change as a result of impact training?' has the options, Yes, No, *Too early to say*.

Do you suspect alternative intended/unintended outcomes?

Are you learning from it?

Does this show that the needs are greater than first thought, perhaps more funding is required

Honest and wise
