





Case studies

One worker needed to fill in an Excel sheet of outputs for their funder, but did not have the background in IT and was very stretched in running the project. A quick session covered this which will save the worker time well into the future and allow more flexibility on reporting across different time periods.

One group were newly established and had some funding to help people in Bexley, but could not find a way to use it. I put them in touch with a group and also did some training with them. They joined a partnership which resulted in families being fed over the lockdown period.

One group were finding it difficult to gain funding. They joined various Impact training sessions and requested a brief 1-2-1 slot. They later wrote to thank me, saying 'our bid was a lot stronger due to your input,' their grant had been successful! This was followed up with further training for a Kickstart volunteer.
